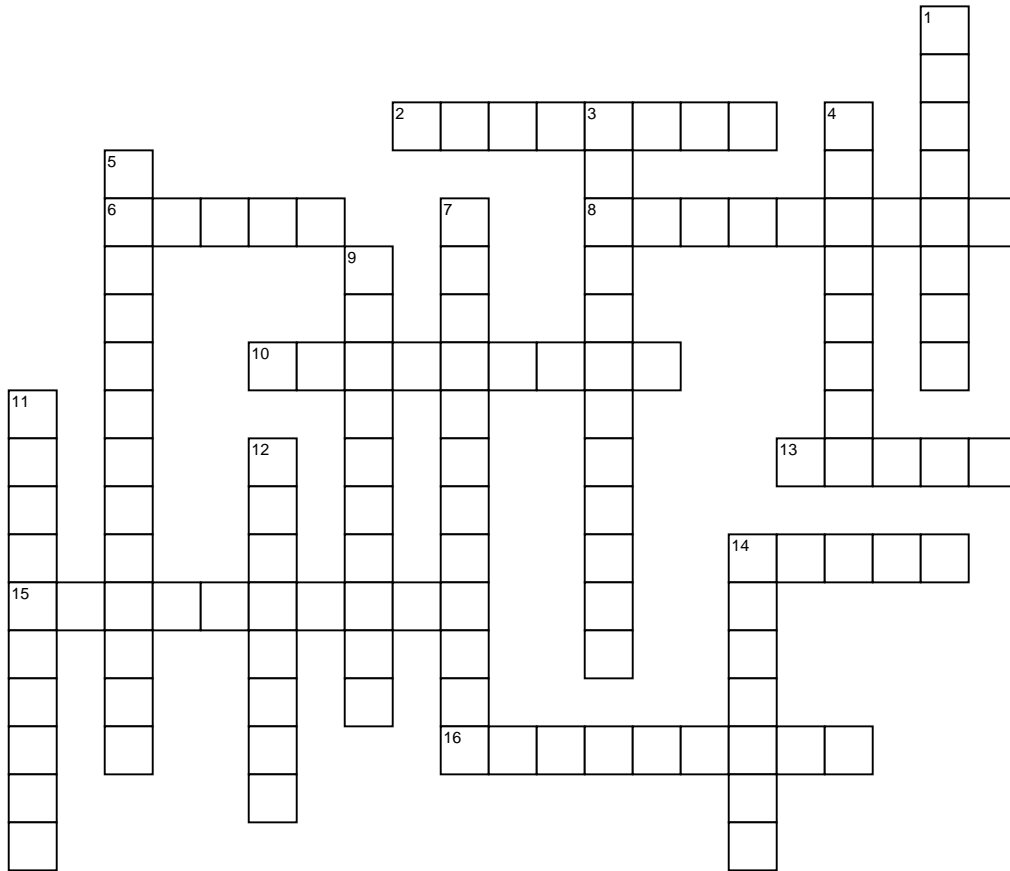


# Crinoids

### ACROSS

- 2 a relative to the crinoids, they usually have five arms
- 6 another name for the aboral cup
- 8 the part of a crinoid that attaches to the stalk and the arms
- 10 the common name for stalked crinoids
- 13 the part of a crinoid that holds the crown up off the sea floor
- 14 tiny hook like structures comatulids use to move around
- 15 a group of crinoids without stalks
- 16 a kind of rock that can form from the bodies of crinoids

- 3 the common name for unstalked crinoids
- 4 a rootlike structure stalked crinoids use to anchor themselves to the ocean floor
